

New Xmas Tudor Music Workshops with *Wylde* *Noyse*

Wylde Noyse have put together a new program for their Tudor Xmas Workshops: New tunes, songs, dances and costumes revitalise the workshops we have provided to schools for the last 5 years. The spring will also see new seasonal programs for spring and summer, so if you're due to "do" Tudors later in the year do stash this flier away and get in touch when the time comes.

Wylde Noyse are father and daughter team Chris and Lizzie Gutteridge who have been performing historical music together for the last decade. The combination of Chris' lifelong fascination with the history of ordinary people and musicians and Lizzie's teaching and workshop leading training and experience make their sessions an entertaining and educational introduction to the music and musicians of Tudor times.

Lizzie and Chris visit schools in colourful authentic costumes and perform on authentic reproductions of shawms, sackbut, cornett, lysard, bagpipes, early recorders, lute, cittern, viella, and harp. They explain how each instrument works, how it compares to modern instruments and who would have played it, when and where.

Each session also includes interactive, hands-on activities: playing along with tunes on drums and stringed instruments, singing original songs and learning a dance. Music is provided in advance so that pupils with instrumental lessons can learn tunes to play in the sessions. Our website includes resources for use in the classroom, with printable music and words for the tunes and songs, steps for the dances and pictures and videos of the instruments, and if you would like a better reminder of the sounds of our instruments our CD "Kings to Cuckolds" is available for £10.



Sessions can be as long or short as you wish to make them. The most popular format is a series of 1 hour workshops for 30-60 pupils. A half day (2 hours) costs £200, or a whole day (4 hours) £300. A performance to the whole school in assembly can also be included in that time, either as an introductory concert or as a demonstration to the rest of the school of what the pupils have learnt at the end of the day.
